- **Confirmation that the applicant meets the eligibility criteria of the scheme:**
  - An applicant to this call must be **within five years of first appointment** as a group leader. They will usually be in the first independent research position, but an applicant in a second independent position who can show that it was a sideways step, and not a promotion, may be eligible.
    - If the applicant has continuously worked full-time, their appointment start date should be **after 6 June 2019**. For full-time appointments this is the earliest start date to be eligible for Round 10 of the scheme.
    - If they have had periods of part-time working and/or long-term leave (such as parental or sick leave), they must have held their current position for less than 60 months full-time-equivalent up to 6 June 2024.
  - An applicant to this call must either hold a permanent position or the Department must provide assurance that their **contract will outlast the duration of the award**. If the applicant's current position does not cover the duration of the award (*i.e. it ends before 28 February 2027*), the department must confirm that the contract will be extended and that there is a commitment to funding their salary beyond the expected end date of the award. The contract extension must occur regardless of the outcome of the application and must be confirmed before the application deadline.
